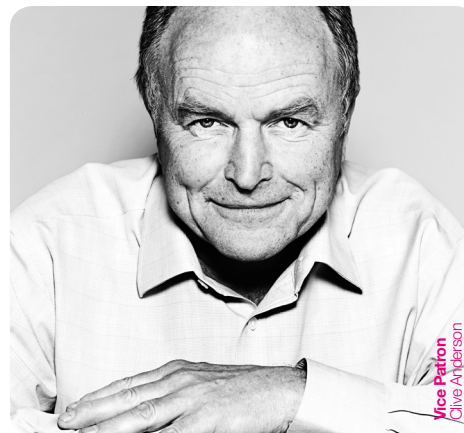
How can I help in other ways, without it costing a penny?
